It also provides POST staff a clear window to track CPT hours for the purpose of compliance audits

12/07/08	1005	Airport Peace Officer Basic Training. This amendment to Regulation 1005 specifies that airport peace officers must complete two basic training requirements – Aviation Security and the Regular Basic Course (RBC).

Penal Code §13517.7 directed the Commission to develop guidelines and training for use by state and local law enforcement officers in addressing issues related to child safety when a caretaker, parent, or guardian is arrested. These guidelines amended Regulation 1081.

These guideline topics are now in Regulation 1081.

Shows the Academy Instructor Development Course requirements that were replaced by the AICC.
